

**Richard Potz** is a tenured professor of canon law at the Institute for Legal Philosophy, Religion and Culture Law, University of Vienna. Since 1978, he supervised the Canon Law and the School of Theology at Holy Cross since 2001 and he has a teaching commitment to the Islamic religion teacher training college in Vienna. Since 1978 he is a board member of the Austrian Society for church law and executive editor and associate editor of the Austrian archives for Law and Religion - formerly Austrian Archives of Canon Law and the Pontificia Commissio consultor Codici Oriental Canon Law Recognoscendo.

From 1991 - 2003 he was chairman of the Academic Board of the Faculty of Law. Since 1995 he has been a regular participant in the Iranian-Austrian theologian / jurist and conferences since 1998 Austrian Member - President since 2001 - the European Consortium for Church and State Research. Since 2002, Prof. Potz coordinator of the elective baskets anthropology of law, religious and cultural rights. Since 2005 he is head of the institute and with the onset of the WS 2006, Vice Dean of the Faculty of Law. He also is a member of the Curriculum of the University of Vienna, since 2006 Member of the Ombudsman's Office, University of Vienna and to ensure good scientific practice and since 2008 member of the Advisory Board of the University of Vienna for the Development Research Centre of European Law and Private Law Reform. His research interests also include the Oriental Churches and Islam in Europe right.
